- A book re-design project in Graphic Design

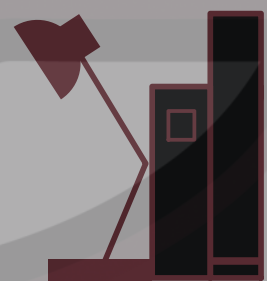


SOCIAL MEDIA
