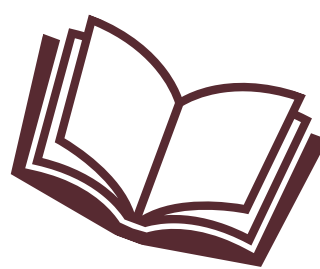


THE WAR EAGLES READ CHALLENGE

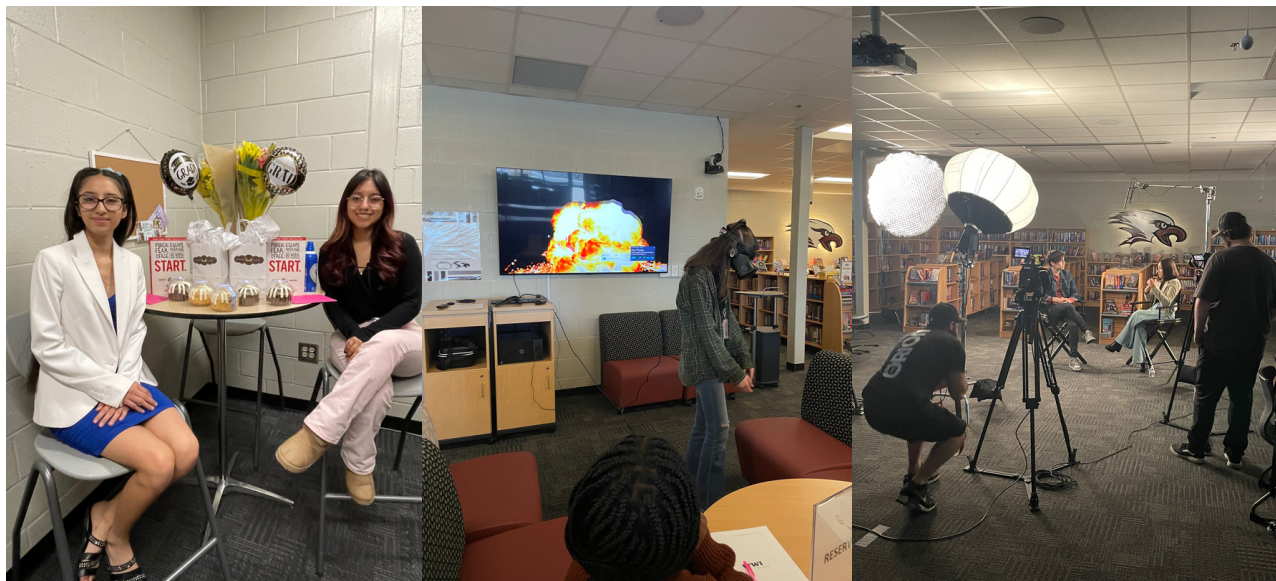
LEARNING COMMONS SPACE
